Insurance companies often **lowball claims** to repair cars after a crash.



If you think it will actually cost **more money** to have your car repaired, you should have a right to a **fair appraisal**.



Through this process, you and your insurance company can appoint **expert appraisers** to determine how much the repair will cost. The expert appraisers and/or umpire will **agree on the final repair costs**.



However, some insurance companies are trying to take this fair appraisal process **away from you**, forcing you to **take their lowball offers** or take the insurance company to court.
