

The Problem: Too often, insurance companies swoop in and try to settle claims on the cheap moments after a wreck. They call the victim, offer a settlement, and ask them to accept it over the phone. Victims may not know the full extent of damages or medical costs. The court case <u>Gilbert v. Fitz</u> makes oral recorded settlement agreements enforceable, giving insurance companies too much power.

The Solution: <u>HB 946</u> by Rep. Cassandra Garcia Hernandez prohibits the use of oral releases, telling insurance companies to **put releases in writing.**
